

ENERGY DEVELOPMENT - THREE PHASE

ED - 3

APPLICABLE:

To all accounts served three-phase for energy development purposes, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Service under this schedule is limited to customers requiring up to 350 kVA of transformer capacity.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Three-Phase, 60 cycles, at standard voltages

RATE:

Basic Charge:	\$42.00	per consumer per month
Energy Charge:	\$0.1184	per kWh per month

Any adjustments to the base rate above shall be reflected on the Rate Rider Tariff Sheet 14.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the greater of the following:

1. The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service, or
2. A charge of \$1.00 per kVA of installed transformer capacity, or
3. The Basic Charge.

TEMPORARY SERVICE:

Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing charges except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting services less the value of material returned to stock. A deposit, in advance, may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill of service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

SERVICE PROVISIONS:

All wiring, poles, lines and other electrical equipment beyond the point of attachment shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

The above charges are net and become due and payable upon the receipt of the statement. A one and one-half percent (1½%) charge will be added to any outstanding balance due fifteen days from the date of mailing indicated on the billing statement.
