
GENERAL INFORMATION - SECTION III (con't)

NET METERING INSTALLATIONS

APPLICABILITY:

In accordance with Wyoming Statute 37-16-101 through 104 and Nebraska Statute 70-2001 through 70-2005, this tariff is applicable to any Member/Owner (Producer) that owns and operates a solar, wind, hydroelectric or biomass generating facility with a capacity of not more than twenty-five (25) kilowatts that is interconnected and operates in parallel with the Cooperative's existing distribution facilities, and is intended primarily to offset part or all of the Producer's own electrical requirements measured by the Cooperative at a Producer's single metered point of attachment.

Only one Producer's electrical load served by a single metering point shall be included in the calculation of net metering against any generation produced by the Producer pursuant to the conditions of this tariff.

This service shall be available to Member/Owners of Wyrulec Company who agree to comply with the requirements of this tariff.

DEFINITIONS:

Net Metering is quantifying the difference between the electricity supplied by the Cooperative and the electricity generated by an eligible Producer and fed back to the Cooperative's system during the applicable billing period.

MONTHLY BILL CALCULATION:

1. Generating facilities directly connected to a Producer's electrical load served by the Cooperative that do not require additional cooperative equipment beyond compliance with statute, shall be billed a monthly Facility Charge in accordance with the Cooperative's approved tariffs.
2. The minimum charge shall be computed as set out in the applicable standard service tariff, including consumer charges, minimum billing amounts, payment or contractual charges.
3. If the electricity supplied by the Cooperative during a given month exceeds the electricity generated by the Producer, the Producer shall be billed for the appropriate monthly minimum or Facilities Charge under the applicable tariff, and energy usage exceeding that generated by the Producer will be billed monthly at the standard applicable rate tariff.

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4. If the electricity supplied by the Producer during a given month exceeds that supplied by the Cooperative, the Producer shall be billed for the appropriate Facilities Charge under the applicable standard service tariff and the Cooperative will compensate the Producer for any excess energy produced as follows:

The rate for credited energy shall be the Cooperative's avoided cost which can be found in the Cooperative's rate tariffs. Said payment for excess power generated shall be calculated and reflected as a dollar and cents credit on the bill for the following month.

5. If a credit balance exists at the end of the year, the Cooperative shall issue payment of same. A credit reflected on the Producer's account at year-end will not be carried forward.

SERVICE CONDITIONS:

1. The Producer is responsible for all costs associated with its facility, for all costs related to any modifications to the facility and for all costs incurred by the Cooperative related to the facility.
2. A Net Metering facility shall meet all applicable safety and performance standards established by the National Electrical Code, the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers Standard 1547, "Standard for Interconnecting Distributed Resources with Electric Power Systems", and Underwriters Laboratories.
3. The Member/Owner shall, at its expense, provide lockable switching equipment capable of isolating the net metering facility from the Cooperative's system. Such equipment shall be approved by the Cooperative and shall be located at the metering point clearly marked as the generator disconnect and be accessible by the Cooperative at all times.
4. The Electric Utility shall not be liable directly or indirectly for permitting or continuing to allow an attachment of a net metering facility, or for the acts or omissions of the consumer-generator that cause loss or injury, including death, to any party.
5. The Cooperative requires a Solid State Bi-Directional meter capable of measuring and displaying delivered and received energy (kWh) on all net metering facilities.
